ECFS TRAVEL GRANTS

As part of the Registration process, there is the possibility of applying for travel grants for young European researchers under the age of 35 as of 21 January 2011. Applicants must submit an abstract to the conference to be considered eligible, and must be registered for a PhD or Post-Graduate Degree, or graduated within 12 months from the application date.
